Dr. Anatelli has also authored/coauthored a number of scientific works in the fields of dermatology, pathology and phototherapy that have been subsequently published in distinguished scientific journals. She has also presented her research work at different national scientific meetings and her investigations have been nominated for the Stowell-Orbison Award at the United States and Canadian Academy of Pathology Annual Meeting. Dr. Anatelli is also passionate about providing leadership, community service, and education to the next generation of dermatologists and dermatopathologists.
