During her medical training at the University of Maryland, School of Medicine, she was awarded the Francis Donaldson Prize for Excellence in Pathology.

Dr. Reese has shown dedication to academics and resident education while serving as a Dermatology Residency Teaching Assistant and Pathology Laboratory Teaching Assistant at the University of Virginia Medical Center and the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania. Dr. Reese has presented at a number of academic conferences on various dermatopathology topics including; Intraepidermal Merkel Cell Carcinoma, Desmoplastic Melanoma, and Cutaneous Lupus Erythematosus.
